### What's Happening?

#### **Sunday August 28th** Safe Church Sunday

On this day we will look at some of what it means for Playford to be a Safe Church.

We will be updating our records with current screening information. If you are involved in any of the following, the Uniting Church needs to undertake a national police history check:

- Parish Mission Council
- Kids Ministry (in all its forms)
- Ministry team leaders
- Ministers, pastors & leaders employed by the church
- Administration staff and office volunteers
- Pastoral Care, Hospital and Aged Care visitors (those representing Playford)
- Life Group Leaders & Hosts

Also anyone with a perceived leadership role. This screening is free of charge to volunteers.

We will also be giving everyone the opportunity to check what personal information we have on record. This is something that we are required to do on a regular basis, and you can ask at any time to check your details.
