But we can only do so much. We pursue one thing always at the expense of something else. Sometimes we can even pursue that which is good at the expense of that which is best.

This weeks passage from Matthew 6:19-24 encourages us to consider what we treasure most and whether what we treasure has value for eternity. I hope to see you on Sunday as we consider what Jesus says about *Treasure Hunters*.
