I find it amazing how many sayings from the Bible have made it into our everyday language. In this weeks passage from Matthew 7, there are three of these statements that seem to get used quite often. Have you ever heard someone say "Take the log out of your own eye!"?

Usually this comes after you may have been trying to help someone see that they have been acting in a way that isn't helpful. You point out their problem, which seems so obvious to you and they respond quite sharply with, "Take the log out of your own eye first!" They may not even realise they have just quoted a Bible verse.

The second saying comes when we walk away, amazed that this person has rejected our wisdom and insight and we proclaim, "Well, I'm not going to be casting my pearls before swine again!" Another quote straight out of Matthew 7.

And we've all heard or said this phrase, "Don't judge me!" Sometimes we even add, "because the Bible says 'Do not judge'." Again from Matthew, chapter 7.

It's funny how we don't like to feel like we've been judged, ever. We hate people pointing out our faults and yet we find it so easy to see the faults of others and sometimes even feel like it is our duty to point them out.

This Sunday's message from Matthew 7:1-6 continues our #SOBLESSED series, with **Blessed are the Log Removers**. We will find out what Jesus says about blind spots, logs, pearls and pigs.
