It is a desperate moment as you go back and rewind just to make sure it wasn't a simple "unplugging" and that in fact the end of the movie will forever remain a mystery.

In a not too dissimilar way, often I will hear someone's review of a movie, ending with the comment "I didn't think much of the ending." So often in this day and age, the ending is simply a lead in to the next movie, How things end matters. I suspect many of us like resolution. A lack of resolution can leave us unsure how to feel and we are left with the challenge to work through why we feel like we do.

How true is that of our own lives? We, like Jonah, and in fact every character in scripture, journeys through life, a life formed by decisions and choices big and small. For all Jonah's ebbing and flowing, even til the very end, there is God, creator of sea and land, abounding in love and compassion, a way through in the midst of a storm, a beginning when all we see is the end.
